

Each owner will need to fill out two copies of the Classification Worksheet/Score Report form **in advance**, and present those sheets to the Classifier upon arrival. The Classifier will then evaluate the animals, note linear score for each trait, and then assign the point scores and total scores. The owner will be provided with a copy of the Score Report and the Classifier will keep a copy to submit to the ADCA Treasurer for official record. The cost is \$10 per animal. For a group meeting or for herds with less than 10 animals, the minimum charge is \$100. The minimum age for classification is 2 years old for either cow or bull; and cows must have had at least one calf prior to being classified for the first time. A cow should be "in milk" when she is classified in order to fully evaluate her mammary system. A dry cow can be evaluated and given a preliminary classification score, however she will not be scored for rear udder cleft or udder depth.
