INFORMATION FOR NEW MEMBERS

The tatoo letter for 1992 is the "B". Most breeders use this in the following manner. The letter of their farm, the number of the calf for the year and then the association letter. An example would be for the Sho-Me Farm:

S3B

The "S" would be the farm letter, the "3" would be the third calf born in 1992 and B would be the association letter.

---

Normally the custom is for members to be responsible for seeing that the paperwork is completed for any animal they sell – this would include the transfer fee. This is done on an individual basis and not all members do this. However, the Association would like to encourage sellers to do so to help the new owner (especially if this is the individual's first Dexter).
