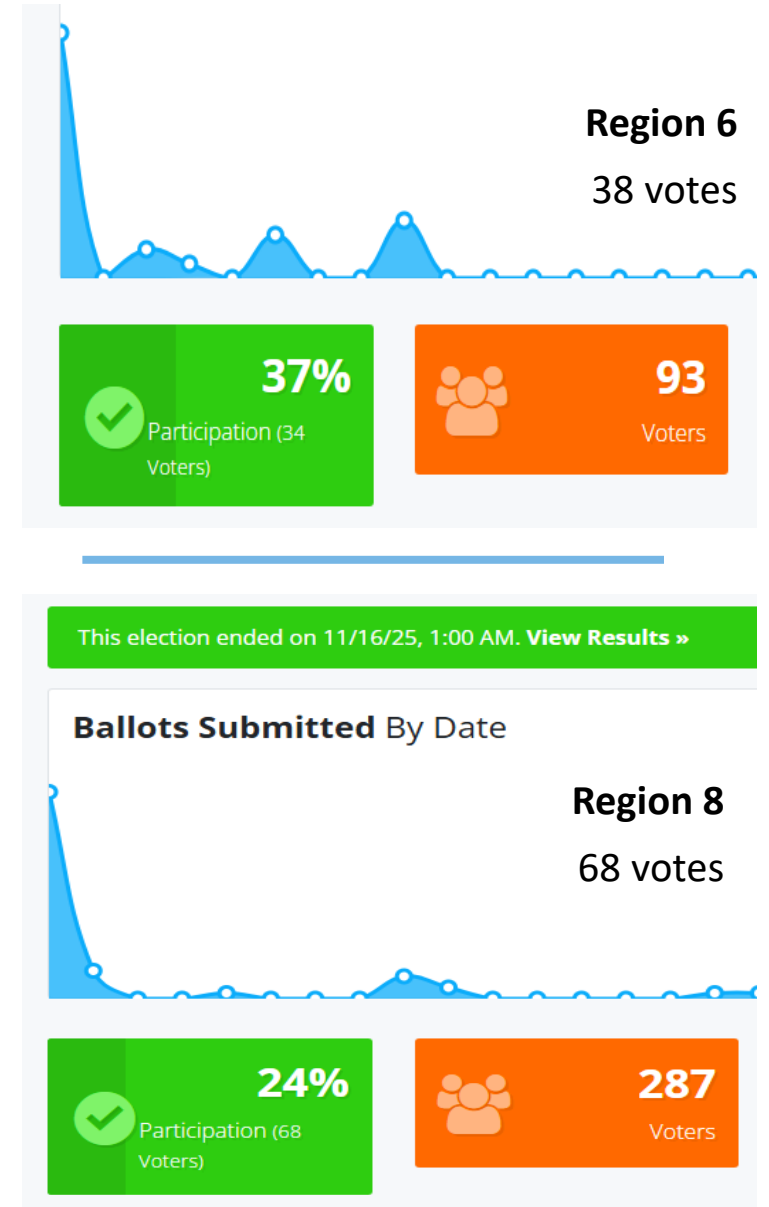
Elections

- Overall, we had better participation than the previous years.



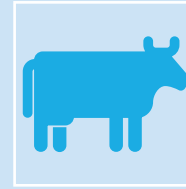
Elections

- The ADCA hopes for more participation in 2026 election with nominations and elections coming up this fall in Regions 9,10, and 12.

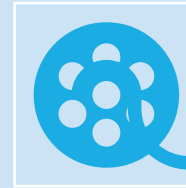

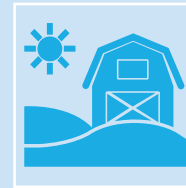

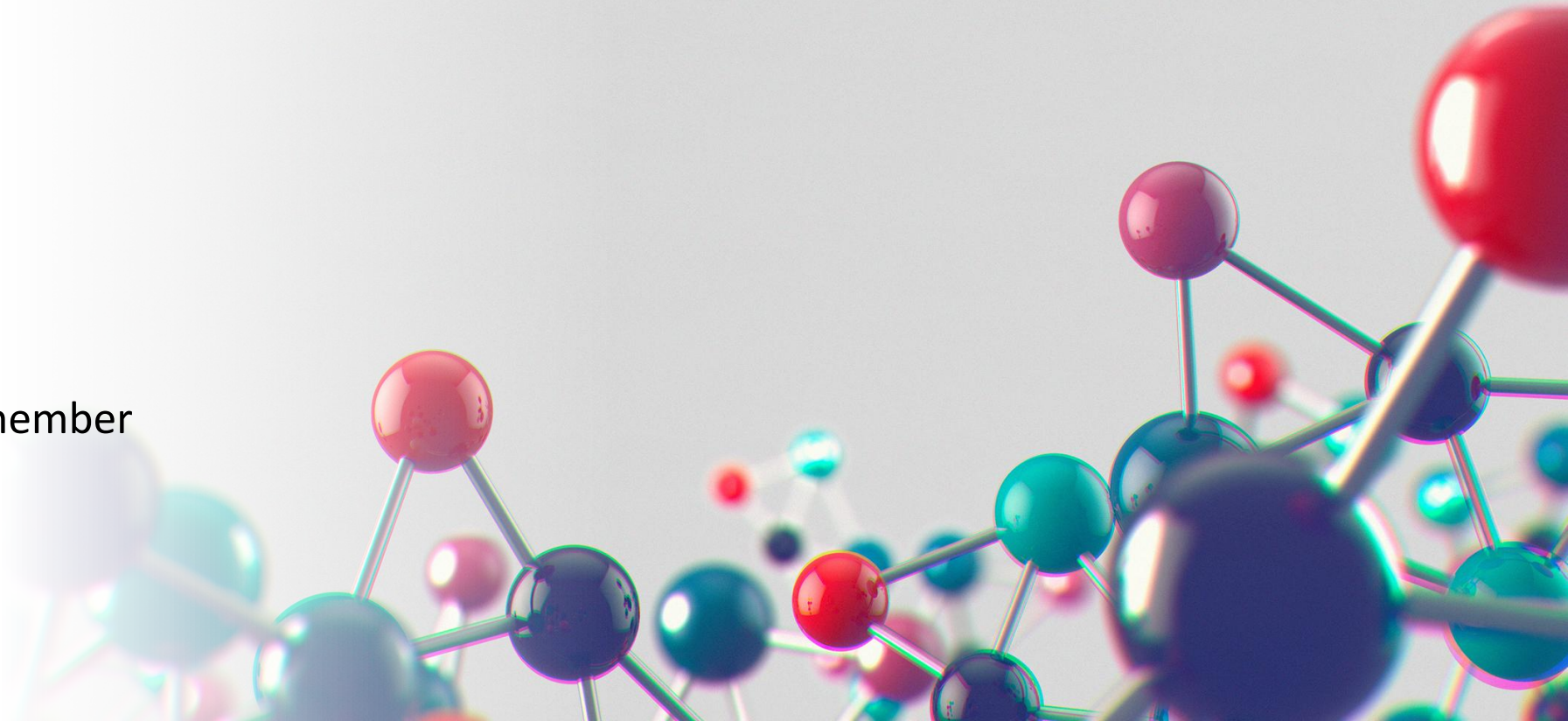

Pedigree and Genetics Committee

Region 11:

- Helped resolve the process to register offspring from ADCA bulls and Legacy cows. Compiled research on the Legacy cow and supplied member with proper steps to registrar offspring.

Region 7:

- Researched and provided a member wanting to import semen with information on the requirements.
- Assisted 2 youth members from Region 4 and 10 with getting the proper paperwork from a buyer so their cattle can be placed in their name.

** The ADCA board advises members needing a derived genotype for registration to consult the P&G committee. If obtaining one is not possible, the committee can confirm this and potentially help members avoid unnecessary costs.*

Pedigree and Genetics Committee

Region 6:

- Helped an Oklahoma breeder identify the correct sire for his calf. Turned out that the cow he purchased as an "open" cow was bred shortly before he picked her up. His bull was not the sire; the previous owner's bull was the sire.

Region 8:

- Helped a Florida breeder identify the correct sire and genotype case number for her calf. The bull in question had two UCD VGL Case numbers, one belonged to a different bull, not the named one recorded in the UCD database. Same error was found in the TAMU database. After identifying the correct case number for the sire, the calf was sire qualified.
- Helped a South Carolina breeder identify the bull she owned, match its genotype with the original recorded genotype, and confirm its registration number. Her bull had been switched with another bull when they were originally sold. Seven years passed before anyone tried to register offspring from her bull. The genotype identified in the TAMU database with her bull, belonged to the other bull. Her bull's genotype was retested and then matched with the genotypes of its dam and sire. The bull's registration information was then updated.

The Retention and Reward Committee is actively working on creating and implementing new programs for each tier level, enhancing the experiences of membership with American Dexter Cattle Association.

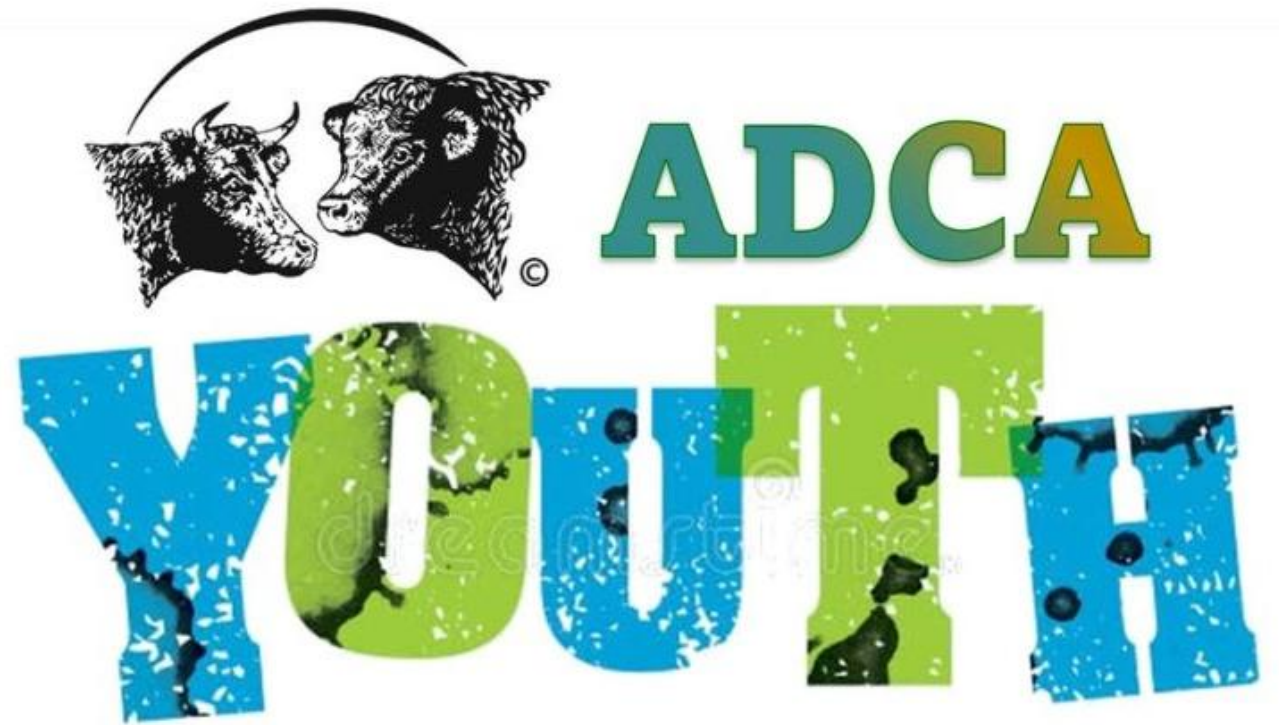

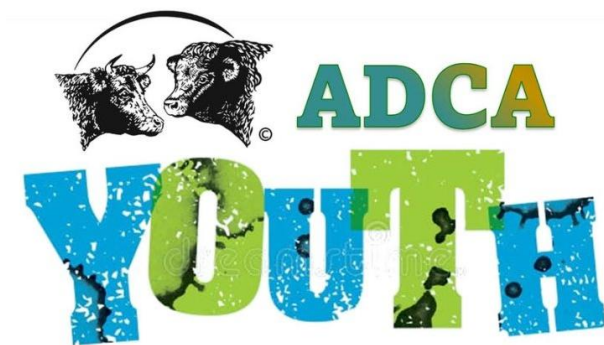

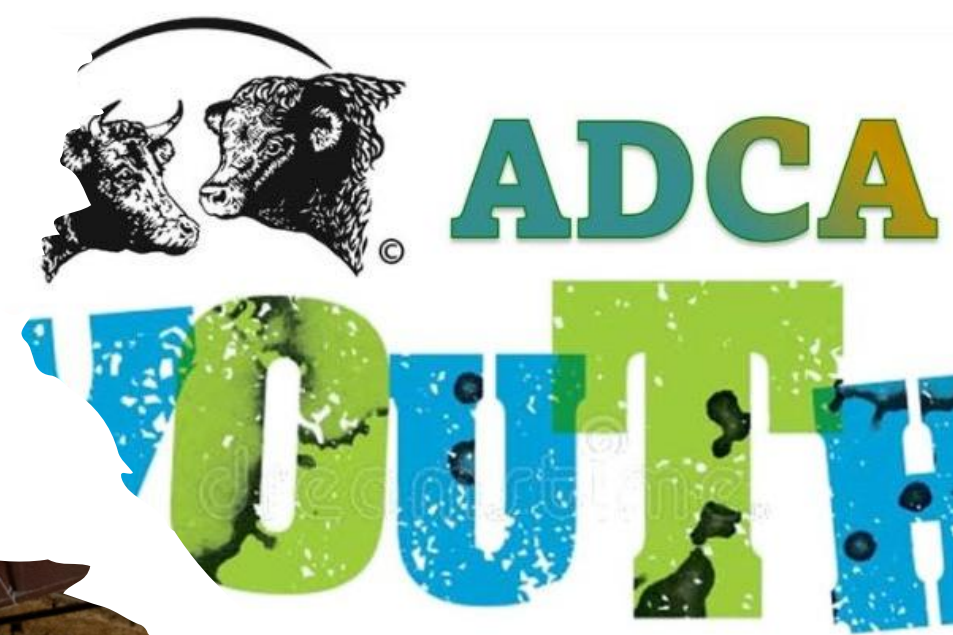
